This is our third year of purchasing quality foods for donation to twenty-four selected pantries in our service area! We will be donating 30 cases (or trays) totaling 360 food items per delivery: 36 cans Kirkland Canned Chicken; 24 jars Peter Pan Peanut Butter; 12 large boxes Kroger Oatmeal; 24 cans Chef Boyardee Ravioli w/beef; 48 boxes Kroger Mac&Cheese; 36 cans Hunt's Spaghetti Sauces (12 each of 3 Varieties); 24 cans Van Camp's Baked Beans; 12 cans Canned Yams; 36 cans Progresso Soups; 12 cans Healthy Choice Soup; and 96 cans Kroger Canned Tuna!

We really want to thank Servpro Northwest for allowing us to store food again at their facility and to Cort Furniture who donated the use of a truck for transportation of much of the food. We could not do this program without such assistance! Thank You!
